

Day tour to Cologne with city tour (5 hours)

The tour takes you to Germany's fourth largest city, Cologne. There, you will explore on foot the area around the Cathedral and the old town. Many sights are concentrated within one square kilometre of the Cathedral, town hall and the old town with the Romanesque church of Groß St. Martin. You can take a look at the Roman Dionysos Mosaic and the Jewish ritual bath, the Mikveh. In the narrow cobble-stoned alleys of the old town and on the busy squares like the Roncalliplatz, the Alter Markt or the Heumarkt, you will get a feeling for life in the cathedral city, yesterday and today. You will see and hear what the people of Cologne and their visitors like to laugh about – not only during Cologne's famous Carnival.



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Visit the most famous building in the city and find out why the people of Cologne wanted to build "the largest church in the world", how difficult it was to realize this enormous project and why it was only completed in the 19th century, after work had stopped for almost 300 years. You will be enchanted by the wonderful stained-glass windows from various centuries, and by the impressive Gero cross, the oldest preserved large crucifix in the Occident and the shrine of the Three Magi, an outstanding example of the Rhenish-Maasland goldsmith's art – and simultaneously proof that Cologne was one of the major occidental centres of pilgrimage.
