Website Policy

1. Introduction

1.1. The International Society for Gastrointestinal Hereditary Tumours (InSiGHT) is an Incorporated Charity with objects to:

- Improve the standard of knowledge including through the identification of genetic predisposition of gastrointestinal hereditary tumour syndromes (GIHTS) and any condition resulting in the GIHTS and the relief of sickness and preservation of health of those suffering from GIHTS and their families.
- Advance the education of the public in all areas relating to GIHTS to include education of the physicians and other healthcare workers in the molecular genetics and clinical management of GIHTS.

1.2. An important vehicle for delivering these objectives is the InSiGHT website, which contains information about the Society, its activities, and activities of others in the field. In addition, it contains information about the hereditary gastrointestinal tumour syndromes and links to other sources of such information.

1.3. The aim of this Website Policy is to document the mechanism by which content for the website is selected.

2. Procedure

2.1. Suggestions of material/links for addition to, or removal from, the website might come to the Secretariat from any source.

2.2. The actual addition/removal of material is done by the Secretariat.

2.3. Prior to adding or removing any material (other than time-expired notices), the Secretariat will inform Council of the proposed content change by email. If no objections have been received after 10 working days, the Secretariat will implement the change.

2.4 This policy may be amended at the discretion of Council.

3. Dispute

3.1 Any disagreements regarding website content will be resolved by a majority vote of Council, with the Chair having a deciding vote if required.
